Installation advice

- Store and install FLOOR 140 dry
- Install the boards laterally, exact and without joints
- Cut with a common woodworking tool
- Diagonal joints are not allowed
- Do not install damaged boards!
- For acoustic decoupling, FLOOR 140 and foundation lath must not be installed with contact to the wall
- Dust extraction in accordance with BG regulations
- Installation elements or inlets (e.g. solar pipes ...), for which temperatures of > 80°C can be expected, must not be installed without any additional fire precautions into the best wood SCHNEIDER® wood fiber insulation materials.
